3. All entries must be properly tagged prior to entry time. Tags are available at the High School on Friday June 30 6:30-8:30 PM
4. No more than one article per class per exhibitor
5. Exhibitors will at all times give the necessary personal attention to their exhibits and at the close of the fair take charge of the same. The Fair Committee will endeavour to prevent the loss or damage to all exhibits but will not be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur.
6. The committee reserves the right to decide any point not covered by rules or regulations
7. Exhibits must conform to the description of the class
8. Unless otherwise specified prizes will be ribbons. Ribbons will be given to the first, second, and third in each class.
